MARINE WORLD

The Texas Marine Mammal Stranding Network is an organization that rescues ocean animals stranded on beaches. Many of its members are volunteers who work for the organization for free. When a dolphin is saved, it is usually put on a stretcher and taken to a rescue centre to recover. If these dolphins are released into the sea again without help, they may die or be easily attacked.

When you see him happily swimming around, it's hard to think that *Cupid* is lucky to be alive. On February 14th, 2003, this bottlenose dolphin was found stranded on a beach in Texas. "When we first saw him on the beach, he just looked pathetic. He was just a sad little dolphin lying on the beach needing help," says Tammy Renaud of the Texas MMS Network. *Cupid*, however, was lucky. A fisherman noticed him and called this organization's rescue team, who immediately rushed the poor creature to their rescue centre pool.

Several volunteers came to help *Cupid* through the dangerous time after his arrival. In fact, they were practically lining up to watch over the poor animal. They took care of him every hour of the day and night. Everyone really wanted the poor animal to get better, but no one knew for sure if this was going to happen or not.

But the volunteers discovered something unnatural about *Cupid*. Swimming on a side or belly-up is not so common among dolphins, and that's exactly what *Cupid* did a lot. Eventually, they discovered the reason: *Cupid* suffers from an illness similar to human epilepsy! So they all thought: would he be able to protect himself if he was in one of such episodes back in the wild? So, the special treatment they gave him was of huge importance for *Cupid's* recovery and soon he became as playful as any other youngster. In time, *Cupid* grew much healthier, but now they had to find him a new home knowing that he would die if they released him back into the sea. The decision was made at last and *Cupid* was transferred to California's Marine World in early 2004.

At first, the people at Marine World California were concerned about *Cupid* getting sick. They decided to keep him away from other dolphins for his safety. After keeping him alone for 30 days, they were really excited to introduce *Cupid* to other dolphins. And so was he. The truth is, dolphins are very social animals and they love to communicate with other animals. They seem to have a special relationship with humans as well. Some people even think that dolphins can help people in danger. Scientists say they have their own special language.

Nowadays, *Cupid* has a happy future ahead of him. He was lucky that he survived being stranded, and especially lucky to have met all those wonderful volunteers. Without them, and all of their hard work, there probably wouldn't be a friendly dolphin named *Cupid*.
